Meadowlea Guesthouse is just a five-minute walk down the hill from Okehampton Railway Station, so you can leave the car at home and travel to Okehampton on the recently re-installed Dartmoor Line from Exeter. The towns selection of pubs and restaurants are only a few minutes' walk down the road. For those of you on budgets there is a microwave in the breakfast room, and we are happy to provide warmed plates and cutlery, if you prefer not to eat out every night.

Our 7 rooms (4 en-suite) are central heated, have flat screen digital colour TV's, hairdryers and tea/coffee making facilities. We have a quiet guest lounge where you can relax with a book, play board games or surf the net with our Wi-fi access. There is parking available, and we have secure storage for cycles, and we have installed a heated drying cupboard.



### Woodland Wildlife Walks with Raven Quest

1. From the picturesque old Okehampton station, take a guided walking 'taxi' through the wild Dartmoor woodlands and into town where you can choose to visit a range of interesting shops and attractions, or stop and find refreshment at the friendly cafes or pubs.
2. For a more adventurous day out, choose an option to head out to the edge of the moor where your route can include ancient woodlands, wildflowers, rushing rivers and habitats for scarce woodland creatures. Also, discover the origins of Okehampton at medieval or iron age settlements.

Either book online, email or call the walk guide who is a local naturalist and wildlife expert and will ensure you have a Dartmoor day out to remember.
